Museum shares pictures of Royal visits to Torbay

Torquay Museum's picture archive has revealed these images of Prince Philip and the Queen on several visits to Torbay and South Devon.

The selection of photographs includes a visit to Torquay Town Hall in May, 1956.

The Queen's silver jubilee year saw a visit to Beacon Quay,

Torquay, in August, 1977.
And in 1988, the Royal couple were photographed during a visit to Brixham.
